Code of Conduct

- 1. Treat all with respect and avoid harming others.
- 2. Be genuine, curious, and truthful. Listen to others.
- 3. Care for everyone's well-being. Be kind and generous to all without prejudice.
- 4. Learn from each other.
- 5. Give kind and honest feedback. Be open to receiving feedback from others.
- 6. Bring your unique perspective and talents to the community and appreciate others'.
- 7. Consume only what you need. Avoid wasting resources.
- 8. Support an environment that is free from discrimination of any kind.

The following behaviors are considered misconduct:

- 1. Harassment, bullying, verbal abuse, violent or physically aggressive behavior.
- 2. Discrimination against an individual or group on the basis of actual or perceived gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, socio-economic status, age, country of origin, nationality, citizenship status, native language, physical appearance, or physical abilities.
- 3. Sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- 4. Taking of resources that are not freely given.

Anyone may report any concern or misconduct, and will be supported in doing so.
